

Lesson 13 Shopping List

Welcoming

- scissors
- stick glue
- large butcher paper to cover the table (or a sheet of paper per child)
- markers or crayons
- seasonal cards or stickers such as Valentine's Day, Christmas, Easter, or party catalog with photos of seasonal items

Gathering

- For display on the prayer table:
- one or two items that the children will recognize as birthday party materials (birthday candles, party hats, etc.)
 - one or two items that the children will recognize as holiday decorations (Christmas, Easter, Valentine's Day, etc.)
 - plate with a piece of flat bread
 - glass with a small amount of grape juice

Exploring

Select one or more of the following activities:

1. Child/Family Activity Sheet

- crayons

2. Celebration Station

- table lined with a tablecloth or butcher paper
- glue
- scissors
- hole puncher
- ribbon/yarn/pipe cleaner
- 6" or 7" paper plates
- markers or crayons

- decorative items such as stickers, cotton, colored paper
- seasonal stickers for St. Valentine's Day, Easter, etc.

3. Family Story Time

- child-friendly Scripture stories
- picture Missal for children
- other secular books about families and celebrations
