

Lesson 19 Additional Activities

Materials



Exploring

1. Loving Others Puppet Show

- tri-fold project board, 36"x 48", with a section of the middle piece cut out to make a free-standing puppet stage, or make your own by folding cardboard into three sections and cutting a section of the middle piece out
- paper doll figures, the injured man, the priest, the Levite, and the Good Samaritan, made previously for Discovering (Activity Master 20)



2. "Growing in Jesus' Love" Portrait

- bowls of white school glue
- shakers of colored glitter
- paintbrushes
- card stock
- marker



Before the lesson: For each child, on card stock, create an outline of a flower using a colored marker. Make each flower large enough for the children to draw in the middle of it.

Helping Others (Easel Painting)

- easel(s) or painting table
- washable tempera paints
- paint apron/smock
- clean brushes
- easel or painting paper



Before the lesson: Set up the easel(s) or painting table and needed supplies.

1. Loving Others Puppet Show

- Place the tri-fold puppet theater near the edge of a table along with the paper doll figures from Discovering (Activity Master 20).
- Position a few chairs in front of the table for the audience. Invite children to reenact the story of The Good Samaritan using the figures as puppets.



2. "Growing in Jesus' Love" Portrait

- Share that just like flowers grow, the children are growing every day in Jesus' love.
- Invite them to draw a self-portrait in the center of a flower, paint the flower petals and stem with glue, and then sprinkle the glue with glitter and let their paintings dry.
- Encourage them to take their paintings home to show their families how they are growing in Jesus' love.



3. Helping Others (Easel Painting)

- Invite the children to show ways people help one another.
- Be sure the children wear a smock to keep their clothes clean. If there are a few children painting at once, encourage them to practice good manners and to share the work space.
