

Lesson 28 Additional Lesson Extension

Materials

Discovering Story Activity

- ❑ white poster board, approximately 22" x 28"
- ❑ markers for the children
- ❑ adhesive tape or other method to hang the drawing

Before the lesson:

- Find a way to quickly display the banner near the Discovering area. You will be bringing it from the Sacred Space to the Discovering area. Choose a prominent place for this.
- Have the poster board and markers ready.

Discovering Story Activity

- After you read the story “The Day the Holy Spirit Came” (Catechist/Teacher Guide, page 307), continue with the following.

That is the end of the story. It is a story so important that we are going to make a mural, which is a very large drawing about it.

- Encourage the children to begin drawing as you reread the story.
- If appropriate, discuss briefly with the group the following questions.

**How did the Apostles look? (happy, surprised, jumping up and down, etc.)
What color do you think the little fires were?
How can you draw the Apostles to look excited?**

Can you draw many people getting baptized? If Jesus’ followers saw a hungry child, what do you think they did? Show that.

Can you show the sharing of money or toys? You can draw them eating or praying together.

- After the drawing is complete, display it in a place of honor. Entitle it Pentecost.
