Discovering	<input type="checkbox"/> Bible <input type="checkbox"/> photo of a Jewish Torah scroll (<i>possible source: on the Internet, search "pictures of Jewish scrolls or Torah"</i>)
Exploring	Select one or more of the following activities: 1. Child/Family Activity Sheet <input type="checkbox"/> crayons or markers <input type="checkbox"/> two cardboard rolls, such as from aluminum foil <input type="checkbox"/> tape 2. My Book of Scripture Stories <input type="checkbox"/> scissors, one per child <input type="checkbox"/> crayons or markers <input type="checkbox"/> ribbon, 18" long, 1" wide <input type="checkbox"/> ribbons, 6" long, 1" wide <input type="checkbox"/> three small bells with holes to thread the narrow ribbon through 3. Scripture Scrolls <input type="checkbox"/> crayons or markers <input type="checkbox"/> roll of nonadhesive shelf paper, a neutral color with no patterns so that you can draw on it with crayons or markers <input type="checkbox"/> felt, any color, 14" x 24" <input type="checkbox"/> thread and sewing needle or fabric glue <input type="checkbox"/> felt symbols, about 3" high, such as a star of David, a dove of peace, or a candle <input type="checkbox"/> glue
